- Booths should be set up by 10:30 and not dismantled until after 2 pm; to make special arrangements contact us dnlgbtq@gmail.com

Food vendors may start selling at 9 am and stay until 3; and sell during the evening program from 6 to 9 pm.

Food Booth Requirements:

1. No flammable or combustible paper or other type of decorations such as paper streamers will be permitted in the proximity of heating, cooking, or warming devices.
2. LPG tanks are to be secured in such a manner as to prevent them being knocked over, and kept away from heating sources.
3. The filling of LPG tanks on location is ABSOLUTLEY PROHIBITED!
4. ALL food booths should have readily accessible 2A-10BC (multi-purpose) dry chemical fire extinguishers with a current service tag intact.
